In this role, he represented the Public Employees Retirement System (PERS) in litigation disputes and counseled the Economic Development Authority (EDA) on public financial programs and debt recovery. Nicholas also provided guidance to the Fort Monmouth Economic Revitalization Authority (FMERA), implementing effective risk avoidance strategies to ensure compliance with state and federal regulations.

Nicholas earned his J.D. from New York Law School in 2022, receiving the Dean's Merit Scholarship and appearing on the Dean's List with High Honors. He participated in the Vis International Commercial Arbitration Moot, served as a mentor in the Latinx Inspiring the Future Mentorship Program, and was a member of the Center for Business & Financial Law.
